Date: October 25 – 27, 2024

Location: Outdoor Adventure, Lake Shore Resort, 4392 N Irish Rd, Davison, MI 48423

Cost: Thanks to the generosity of Outdoor Adventurers, we are able to offer this program free to families

How many people can I bring: Cabins hold up to six people and each family will be assigned one cabin

Will Special Days have staff to watch my kids: No. We will provide some activities, but you will be responsible for supervision of your children during the weekend. There is an indoor pool so you **MUST** be with your children when swimming and this activity is at your own risk.

Schedule:

Friday, October 25th: You are welcome to arrive any time after 5pm. We will plan to have dinner at approximately 7pm with a happy hour before dinner followed by a movie and campfire.

Saturday, October 26th: Breakfast will be on your own (your cabin will have a small kitchen). Activities will be offered from 10 am – noon and a lunch of hamburgers and hotdogs with sides will follow at 12:30pm. Activities will be offered again from 2 – 5pm with a happy hour and potluck dinner with a soup/chili/stew contest at 6pm.

Sunday, October 27th: Breakfast will be on your own (your cabin will have a small kitchen). Check out at 10am – See Ya Later Bye

Sunday, October 26th:

Breakfast: On your own (your cabin will have a small kitchen)

10am: Check Out

Food and Beverage: Each cabin has a kitchen for your use during your stay. Please plan to provide your own breakfast for your family both days. Camp will provide pizza Friday night, hamburgers, hot dogs and sides for Saturday lunch. Saturday dinner will be a potluck / soup bar and we ask each family to bring a dish to share. If you would like to participate in the soup/chili/stew contest please bring your entry and prizes will be awarded. The camp property has a store with limited items for sale. You should bring your own beverages (alcohol is permitted and we will host a happy hour on Friday and Saturday before dinner) and snacks. If you have any special dietary needs, please plan to bring any food you would need to accommodate those.

Animals: There are no animals allowed at camp except service animals pursuant to ADA guidelines

Medical Support: We will have skeleton medical crew with first aid supplies. You will be responsible for bringing, storing and administering any medications for your family.

Transportation: We will not be providing transportation to attend family camp but also do not want the cost of transportation to be a barrier for families to attend.
